LEADERSHIP CRAWFORD COUNTY REQUIREMENTS:

All Leadership Crawford County class members must:

1. Live or work in Crawford County;
2. Have an interest in seeking key volunteer, public office, board or commission roles;
3. Possess high standards of personal integrity;
4. Possess potential leadership ability and a personal commitment to solving community problems;
5. Be willing and able to commit the time necessary to complete the program. Mandatory time commitments include the nine (9) partial-day sessions (10:00 am to 4:00 pm) scheduled for September 12, October 10, November 14, December 12, January 9, February 13, March 13, April 10, and May 8 and a Graduation Banquet later in May, time to be determined later.
6. Arriver on time for each class session and be in attendance the entire session;
7. Use of cell phones and pages will not be allowed during the program and will be restricted to scheduled breaks only;
8. Participate in a community project to learn first-hand about community needs and issues. Prepare for each session with appropriate readings and assignments. These activities will require time in addition to that spent in class sessions;

The *Leadership Crawford County* Selection committee will choose a maximum of twenty (20) students for the 2008-2009 class. Participants will be chosen through a comparative assessment form all applications received. The intent of this selection process is to create a group of the best quality candidates, which represent a cross section of interests within Crawford County.
